The intermediate French class this year took on students with good basic powers of expression and worked on expanding their vocabulary so as to enable them to discuss a broader range of topics in French. As well as revising the basic grammar of the present, past perfect and future tenses, the class covered topics on personalities, stereotypes, nations, tourism and the preparation of food.
